- Pretend you're an astronaut completing different space missions, make a book about your work.
- Make a telescope, or a solar system using creative/junk modelling resources.
- Research information about Tim Peake or a different famous astronaut.
- Make up your own space rhyme or song, record this on a ipad or tablet or just simply remember to perform to your class.

Please bring the projects back to school by **Monday 15th January**.

The children will then share their projects with each other and we will display them in the classroom.

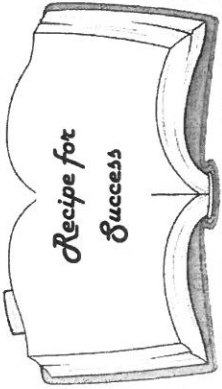

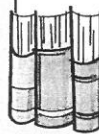
