This term our theme is

Muck, Mess and Mixtures

We would love for the children to enhance their learning in school, by getting involved in a mini project of their choice at home, linked to our theme, Muck, Mess and Mixtures.

Please see the 'Overview/Recipe for Success' for this term which has more detail about what we will be learning.

The following suggestions are by no means exhaustive, but will give you a few ideas as starting points for activities which your child might like to do:

- Cook something and create a picture record of what you have done.
- Take your grown-up shopping and encourage them to buy a food they've never tried before.
- Make your own slush drink.
- Create your own bath. Use measuring jugs and food colouring with water to add different colours to make a "messy" bath!
- Create an original piece of artwork inspired by an artist you admire.
- Write a poem with the title "Muck, Mess and Mixtures."
- Invent a pretend 'potion', adding different ingredients and then write your own recipe or instructions on how you made it!

Remember your child might have much better ideas! Be imaginative about how to record what your child has enjoyed learning about this theme – take photos, make PowerPoints, make posters, videos, create 3d models etc.... We love seeing how they have engaged using their own interests and strengths to develop their individual learning beyond the classroom.
