Reception Trip to Woodside Wildlife and Falconry Park at Langworth

As part of our Animal Magic theme, we have arranged a trip to Woodside Wildlife and Falconry Park at Langworth on Wednesday 16th May for all the children in Reception.

The children will leave school straight after registration and return for the end of the school day. There will be no hot lunches on this day. **Could we please ask you to send your child with sandwiches in a lunchbox to take with them for the trip?** A drink and a snack will be supplied by Lincoln Carlton Academy kitchen. The children who are currently registered as Pupil Premium will have a full lunch provided which will include sandwiches. **If you would like clarification if your child is PP, please check with the class teacher.**

Children will be expected to wear full school uniform during this day. They will need appropriate clothes for the weather, including hat, coat and sun-cream (weather dependent). Children may need to carry their lunch box throughout the day so we ask that all children come to school on the day with a **named rucksack**.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £13.40 to cover the cost of the trip. If there are insufficient funds to cover the cost there is the possibility that the trip might not be able to go ahead. There is an option to pay in instalments, please see the office staff for more information about this.

If you are in receipt of Income Support, Income Based Job Seeking Allowance, support under part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit, provided that Working Tax Credit is not also received and the family's income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) does not exceed £16,190 (currently registered as a Pupil Premium child). If in receipt of any of the above you could be exempt from making a voluntary contribution.
